## April auction

Exchange rate DKK 100 = USD 18.10

The auction opened with a small offering of foxes, which was selectively sold.

The offering of Russian sables was 75% sold at firm prices.

When mink sales started with Silverblue mink, the auction room was crammed. There are approximately 550 customers in the house including a record large number – approximately 400 – from the Far East.

Prices at today's auction were very stable compared to Kopenhagen Fur's February auction. Males were sold at slightly easier prices, whereas prices of females rose slightly. Like in February, there was a great difference in price between good and poor qualities.

The USD rate has dropped approximately 5% since February.
