Exchange rate DKK 100 = USD 17.23

At the third day of the auction a record number of brown mink skins were on offer. The day was awaited with excitement, because this was the day when the world marked price was to be found.

First type under the hammer was Brown males, which were sold at declining prices of 19%. Brown Velvet males dropped 16%. Brown females were in great demand and the skins were sold at prices only slightly below December level. Brown Velvet females fell 6%.

Prices of Glow males dropped 21% and 20% for Classic and Velvet respectively, whereas prices of Classic females went down 5% and Velvet 8%.

Black males went down 22% and Black Velvet males 21%.

Chinchilla had a fantastic sales, as prices fetched as much as 27%. Highest price for a lot in Purple quality was DKK 730 per skin.
