Frequently Asked Questions

Can I enter Denmark?

Yes, you can. Passengers arriving from EU and non-EU countries are allowed to enter Denmark as long as they prove a valid purpose for entry. Business trips are recognised as valid purposes. However, all travelers need to present proof of a valid purpose once they arrive in Denmark, together with their ID and/or Visa.

What documentation do I need to prove valid purpose?

Before your departure, Kopenhagen Fur will provide you with the documentation needed to prove a valid purpose for entering Denmark. This documentation consists of a letter from Kopenhagen Fur as well as a supporting document emitted by the Confederation of Danish Industry, the biggest business association in Denmark. With this documentation, you will be granted permission to enter Denmark during Kopenhagen Fur's auction period, as indicated on the letters.

Will I need a Visa?

- If you have never needed a visa to enter Denmark, you will not need to apply for one.
- If you already have a valid visa, you do not need to make a new application.

Visa requirements have not changed, and the documentation needed to obtain a visa is the same. However, the procedure for handing in visa applications may differ from normal, and you may need to make an appointment to hand in your application. Due to the low levels of visa applications, visas may be expedited faster than usual, but Kopenhagen Fur cannot guarantee this will be the case. If you need a visa, please contact us as soon as possible so that we may assist.

Upon arrival in Denmark, visa holders will need to present their visa as well as the documentation for valid entry purpose provided by Kopenhagen Fur.

My flight to Copenhagen is not direct. Are there special transit rules?

Yes. It is very important that you check which rules apply to your transit.



Will I go under quarantine once I arrive in Denmark?

No, business travelers are not required to go on quarantine upon arrival in Denmark.

However, you are expected to adopt the measures from the Danish Health Authority during your stay. Kopenhagen Fur will provide all attendants with information on these measures as well as the rules applicable during the visit to the Kopenhagen Fur facilities.

Wearing a mask is mandatory in EU airports.

What is the status of COVID-19 in Denmark?

In Denmark, the spread of coronavirus is controlled and stable. There are very few new cases, with no spikes registered in the weeks following the gradual reopening. Deaths are rare, and testing has been made widely available. You can follow the numbers [here](#).

Are there special rules for travelers coming from high-risk areas?

No, there are not. However, we are carefully monitoring the situation, and we will inform you of any new requirements. In any case, we stress the importance of following all safety measures during your stay in Denmark.

What can I expect during my stay in Denmark?

Except for the current travel limitations and the ban on large events such as festivals, most attractions and businesses are open, including restaurants and stores. Opening hours may be shorter than usual. In Denmark, the adoption of safety measures such as social distancing and hygiene standards (frequent disinfection, washing hands, sneezing in the arm) is widespread.

Where will I stay?

Attendants may freely book hotels in Copenhagen, and availability is currently not an issue. Registered participants will receive additional information regarding accommodation possibilities.

Important: during your visit to Kopenhagen Fur

The local authorities have allowed Kopenhagen Fur to hold physical auctions. For maximum compliance, all visitors must follow the measures put in place by both Kopenhagen Fur and the Danish Health Authority. You will find an overview in your Welcome Package.
